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The goals of the Senior Seminar Program are to help prepare seniors to enter the workforce with a job-ready portfolio and the skills necessary to secure and retain employment.

- ❖ All seniors leave CMTHS with a professional portfolio including a resume and other supporting employment documents: a career objective essay, letters of reference, certifications, task lists, photographs and evidence of work, and awards and honors.
- ❖ Seniors are instructed in basic employment concepts related to getting and keeping employment. Seniors participate in workshops identifying job readiness skills including filling out applications and other job related forms, workplace skills, and how to prepare for and go on a job interview.
- ❖ Seniors leave CMTHS with a basic understanding of the monetary concepts involved with taxes, employment, and running a household, including creating a budget, reading a pay statement, bank accounts, paying bills, getting a credit card, and renting their first apartment.
- ❖ Senior Seminar provides accountability for covering many of the PA Career Education and Work Standards.
- ❖ Senior Seminar is supported with a teacher created website which outlines the curriculum and provides resources to students on all of the topics covered.
